1. To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amount to be levied by means of Occupier's Rate for the current year:-

Transfer to Reserve Fund	£5,000.00
Insurance (traders combined policy)	£2,000.00
Insurance (professional indemnity)	£1,000.00
Insurance (public liability)	£160.00
Floral Guernsey	£8,000.00
Environment Committee	£1,000.00
Street lighting	£11,300.00
Contribution to States Cadastre	£5,000.00
Parochial education	£4,725.00

2. To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the sums above.
3. To approve the New Cemetery accounts for 2007 which have been duly audited and to elect two additional members to the New Cemetery Committee.
4. To elect Auditors to audit accounts for the Constables, the New Cemetery Committee, the Treasurer of the Parish School and the Parochial Welfare Fund respectively for the year 2008.
5. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Electors and Ratepayers may deem necessary.
6. Any other business.
