The Constables and Douzaine of the above Parish invite all Ratepayers and Electors to meet at La Salle Paroissiale, Les Buttes, on Wednesday, 10th March 2010, following the meeting of the Rector and Churchwardens at 7.30 p.m., to transact the following business:-

1. To approve the accounts of the Treasurer of the Parochial Cemeteries Committee, which have been duly audited.
2. To approve the accounts of the Trustees of the Parochial School Fund, which have been duly audited.
3. To approve the sum of £94,222.00 to cover the cost of Household Refuse collection and disposal for the year from 1st April 2010, to be levied by means of Refuse Rate.
4. To decide if they are in favour of voting the following sums to be levied by means of Owners Rate:-
 - (a) Ordinary upkeep of Parochial Cemeteries:

(i) Gardening contract	£11,174.56
(ii) General maintenance	£2,500.00
(iii) Vardex edging to paths, infill & gravel, at de Beauvoir Cemetery	£4,845.12
(iv) Extension of Memorial Wall at de Beauvoir Cemetery	£13,222.00
 - (b) Extraordinary repairs to other Parish Properties:

(i) Replacement floor covering at Community Hall	£4,517.00
(ii) Replacement windows at Post Office building	£1,006.85
 - (c) Parochial Administration

(i) Ordinary upkeep of other Parish Properties	£11,269.25
(ii) Administration, Clerical and Legal Expenses	£16,372.72
 - (d) Cost of publishing Parochial Notices £2,700.00 | - (e) Street Lighting £600.00 | - (f) Rente due to Rector £9.53 | - (g) Public Needs to be approved by the Parish:-

(i) Grant to La Houquette Primary School Library	£350.00
(ii) Grant to La Mare de Carteret High School Library	£250.00
(iii) Contribution to Parish Magazine	£250.00
 - (h) Contribution to States Cadastre £1,100.00 |
5. Transfer to Reserve Fund in accordance with the Parochial Taxation (Reserve Funds) (Guernsey) Law, 1997, as amended . £10,000.00
6. (a) To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the above sums by means of Refuse Rate and Owners Rate;
(b) To decide that the said Owners Rate, together with that approved at the meeting convened by the Rector and Churchwardens, shall be levied applying the relative factors approved at the Ratepayers Meeting on 11th March 2009, a copy of which is displayed on the Douzaine Notice Board at St Peter's Post Office or available in the Douzaine Room.
7. To elect two members to the Parochial Cemeteries Committee for three years to replace Mr B. H. Roussel and Mr P. J. Brehaut, whose terms of office will expire in March 2010; both are eligible for re-election.
8. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Ratepayers and Electors may deem advisable.
