The Constables and Douzaine of the parish of Saint Sampson invite the Ratepayers and Electors thereof to attend at Hautes Capelles Junior School, St Sampson, on Wednesday 26th May 2010, immediately after the meeting convened for 7.30 p.m. by the Rector and Churchwardens, for the following business:-

To pass the Constables' accounts for 2009, which have been duly audited and may be inspected at the Constables' Office during office hours up to and including 26th May 2010.

To elect Auditors for the above accounts for 2009.

By the electors only to elect a member of St Sampson's Parochial Cemetery Committee to complete the unexpired term of office of Mr E. H. Noyon, deceased, i.e. to 31st December 2011.

(1) To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amounts to be levied by means of **Owner's Rate** for the current year.

Parochial administration expenses, viz. office supplies, legal expenses, salaries and pension funds, insurance, general upkeep and repair of the Douzaine Room	100,434.62
Cost of parochial notices and publications	4,000.00
Street lighting, including maintenance and repair of lamps	26,838.42
Cadastre expense - contribution	4,500.00
Public needs to be approved by the parish -	
Parochial Cemetery - ordinary upkeep and wages	54,887.97
Education - awards to school children	4,000.00

TOTAL:- £194,661.01

To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for a Remede to lay the agreed expenditure. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Ratepayers and Electors may deem advisable.

(2) To approve that the said Owner's Rate, together with that approved at the meeting convened by the Rector and Churchwardens, shall be levied applying the following relative factors to the TRP unit value of the Cadastre categories listed below:-
